Additional Information

Important: Each group must have a competent leader in charge to liaise with Boulder Creek Holiday Centre staff. This appointed person must ensure that campers understand Boulder Creek Holiday Centre rules and procedures as detailed below.

Daily Duties: Camp is to be maintained in a clean condition by the campers. Mopping of showers and arrangement for disposal of rubbish is the responsibility of the camp group; alternatively staff will take responsibility - charges apply

Drinking water: Purified drinking water is available from taps within the complex. (excluding garden taps)

What to bring: Sleeping bag or fitted sheet with top sheet & blankets, pillow, towel, toiletries, hat, sunscreen, personal needs, insect repellent and torch. A limited number of pillows, sheets and blankets are available at additional cost.

Groups who self-cater need to supply their own crockery, cutlery, cooking utensils (there are limited pots and pans for campers use)

Arrival/Departure: Unless special arrangements are made, campers must not enter the camp prior to the allocated time and must not overstay the allocated departure time as staff has the responsibility to clean and prepare rooms.

Emergency Procedures: Notices are posted throughout the camp and campers should make themselves familiar with the arrangements.

- **Fire Fighting Equipment** - Extinguishers, fire hoses and smoke detectors are vital and are located around the site. These must not be tampered with or removed.
- **Fires** - No fire or BBQ may be lit on the property without the consent of Camp Staff. Fire restriction notices and Total Fire Ban Days must be strictly observed.

First Aid: First aid is the responsibility of campers. Campers must provide their own first aid equipment.

Property:

- **Damage and loss** - All breakages and losses to **Boulder Creek Holiday Centre** property or equipment are to be reported to Camp Staff and the cost of replacement will be charged and paid for before leaving camp. **Boulder Creek Holiday Centre** takes no responsibility for the loss or damage to personal property. Campers are only permitted to access the buildings/rooms to which they have been allocated to the group when booking.
- **Parking:** All vehicle parking is strictly at the owner's risk and only in designated car parks. Speed restrictions apply.
- **The environment:** **Boulder Creek Holiday Centre** is part of a sanctuary for flora and fauna. National Park rules apply. No camper is permitted to bring firearms, animals (unless it is part of an agreed program) or pets onto the property or to disturb the natural environment.
- **Smoke free environment:** All buildings are designated smoke free zones.
- **Alcohol/Drugs:** **Boulder Creek Holiday Centre** is an alcohol and drug (non-prescription) free zone

- **Emergency calls:** Camp Staff is to be informed of any emergency.
- **Private calls:** Some mobile phone reception in this area is poor. Alternate arrangements can be made.

Fans and Mozzie zappers for summer use in bedrooms: These are to be turned off when not in use. Zappers are effective for about 10 hours. Therefore they are to be used at night time and turned off during the day. A replacement will be given to the leader for each room occupied. (One insert each night).

Safety – Program Activities: For safety and insurance reasons it is necessary that activities are discussed with staff and **Boulder Creek Holiday Centre** staff reserves the right to withdraw equipment or access to on-site activities should the venue/equipment not be used appropriately.

Group Leader: The group leaders must ensure that any injury sustained during occupancy at **Boulder Creek Holiday Centre** is reported when it happens. No responsibility is accepted for unreported accidents.

Terminating Occupancy: **Boulder Creek Holiday Centre** Camp Staff are empowered to take action as deemed necessary for the proper conduct of the camp and terminate the occupancy in extreme situations.

Minimum Numbers: A minimum number charge exists for the hire of the camp if numbers drop significantly following the booking.

Behaviour: Care and common sense should be taken when in the camp buildings. All noise should commence after 7.30am and cease by 10.00pm, unless otherwise agreed. Lights and fans should be turned off when not in use.

Food and drink may only be consumed in the dining room, BBQ area and out of doors. Campers are **NOT** permitted to bring food or drink onto carpeted areas.
